




5 NT in this Stayman sequence offers choice of  $6 \triangleq$  or 6 NT.

6 **by** North Opening Lead:  $\bigstar 5$ 

You have ten top tricks.

- In notrump you need the  $\diamond$  finesse plus a miracle to make.
- In 6  $\clubsuit$ , you simply ruff two  $\heartsuit$ 's, and then draw trump.



After two strains have been bid, 5 NT is forcing and asks Partner to pick the best slam.

## 6 NT by East Opening Lead: 10

North starts with 4 + 2 + 3 + 0 = nine winners and can promote two + tricks. (That's eleven.) What can be done with  $\vee$  and/or  $\diamond$  to get a twelfth trick? Does North play a role?
