## COMPETITIVE DOUBLE

$\Rightarrow$ After a suit opening bid, Responder's double of an enemy raised-suit is useless as a penalty double. Double of a raised suit is best used as a "competitive double". A "competitive double" shows values to compete, but also uncertainty about where to compete.

But these are not competitive doubles:
(1) Partner has bid notrump.
(2) Your side has already found a fit.
(3) You passed at your previous turn. (penalty pass)
$\Rightarrow$ Applies through a raise to $2 \wedge$ or $3 \wedge$ or $4 \star$.

## $\Rightarrow$ Minimum Strength Requirements

Two-level: Double shows at least a Queen extra. Three-level: Double shows at least an Ace extra. There is no upper limit. Doubler may bid again.

## $\Rightarrow$ After a Competitive Double

Partner chooses the contract. Passing the double requires four trumps, or three trumps at 3-level.

## Double of Artificial Bid Shows Strength in Bid Suit - Double of Stayman and Jacoby Transfer - Double of 4SF and Stopper-Showing Bid - Double of Control-Bid \& Blackwood Response

## Double of 3NT is a Penalty Double

 " Opponents have minimum game values.- Prudent double does not help Declarer play.
- You are on lead:
- Have a good suit to lead.
- Unpleasant surprise for Declarer
- Partner is on lead:
- Defender's suit - lead the suit we have bid.
" Dummy's suit - "I am strong in Dummy's suit."
- No suits bid - Doubler's strong major suit.
" Without "double", Partner likely gives a trick.
Double of Suit Slam (They intend to make it) - Increase likelihood of getting two tricks.
" Don't lead a trump; make an unusual lead.
- Draws attention to your shortest suit.


## Double of Suit Slam (They are sacrificing)

 " Maximize penalty. "Don't bid any higher."- No particular lead is indicated.
