Palo Alto Sectional Scores Again!

Another Firecracker Sectional, another success! The annual sectional was held at the Elks Lodge Wednesday, July 3 through Sunday, July 7. There were 660 tables for 9 sessions with an average of 73 tables per session. In the 2001 tournament, the total was 706 for 10 sessions with a 71 table-average per session. See page 4 for the financial report

The top attendance was on Friday afternoon with 106 tables, followed closely with 102.5 on Saturday afternoon. The table count was 49.5 for Wednesday, 135 for Thursday, 180.5 for Friday, 161.5 for Saturday and 134 for Sunday. An encouraging statistic is the 111 tables of I/N, which is a 14 table average per session, the same average as in 2001.

Of course, the Unit owes much of the success to the Firecracker Sectional chairman, Lorna Corbetta and her committee chairs, Mary Ann Larkin in hospitality, Ginger Herrick with partnerships and Gloria Leitstein, caddy master. Equally important were the players who pitched in to help with hospitality and partnership. The holiday decorations, personal warmth of committee members and the orderly tournament management contributed to the ambience.

Beginning Bridge Lessons Starting September 5 - SPREAD THE WORD

The very popular Frank Smoot teaches the four-part Audrey Grant series, appropriately titled Clubs, Diamonds, Hearts and Spades. This is Frank's eighth year teaching this class! The cost per series is \$70 which includes the cost of the book.

Class times and place: Thursdays (note new day) from 7:00-10:00 p.m. at our beautiful new Bridge Club on Terminal Boulevard in Mountain View. The first series starts on Thursday, September 5. Players can earn extra master points and qualify for the next level The Unit final will be a twosession event on Saturday, October 19 in which qualifiers can earn a place in the district final.

Players who place in the overalls in their respective strata earn sectional-rated half red and half black master points. Any player who scores average or higher or finishes in the upper half will be eligible for the Unit final.

It Seems to Me

To be a good bridge player you have to pay attention to everything that happens at the table. To be a better player you must also pay attention to what does not happen.

This hand is a good example:

You sit South and must pick up both red kings to make your contract. West leads the two of hearts. You win with the jack. How do you play the diamonds?

Ordinarily the odds favor taking the diamond finesse, but you have some information from what didn't happen. West did not lead a high club. If he had held both the ace and king, surely he would have preferred that lead to the small heart. Therefore, East must hold either the ace or king of clubs. If East also held the king of diamonds, he would have had enough to bid at least one no trump on the first round of bidding. But East passed and therefore cannot have the king of diamonds.

Your only chance to make the contract is that West's king of diamonds is a singleton. So, on the second trick you play the ace of diamonds. Fortunately, the king drops. But even if it didn't, you have the satisfaction of knowing you made the correct play.
