Safety First by Ernst Jacobi

South plays 3NT. West leads the 4 of hearts to the 9, the 3 from East, to your 2. You are playing a "team" game, how can you assure the game?

Solution: You play a small club to the 9 so that East does not take the lead. Even if West has the jack, your king of hearts is protected and you can always make a minimum of 10 tricks.
