## Firecracker Sets Bridge World Ablaze!

The Unit Firecracker Sectional was fabulous! The unit hosted the annual sectional at Rickey's Hyatt on Wednesday, July 2 through Sunday, July 6.

There were 712.5 tables for 9 sessions with an average of 79 tables per session. This total easily tops the 660 in 2002. The 712 table-count is the largest since 2000 when there were 725 for 10 sessions. In 1998, the 9-session tournament had 748 tables. Was it the change in venue, the addition of a pairs game to the Sunday schedule, the earlier start and finish times, that increased the attendance?

The top attendance was on Saturday afternoon with 100.5 tables, followed closely with 100 on Thursday afternoon. The table count was 48.5 for Wednesday, 171.5 for Thursday, 159.5 for Friday, 168.5 for Saturday and 164.5 for Sunday. On Sunday, there were 69.5 teams in the Swiss and 25.5 in the pairs game. The I/N table count was 124, an average of 15.5 per session, versus a 14 average in 2002.

What makes a successful sectional? It's the hard work and dedication of many including the Firecracker Sectional chairman, Merle Orelove and her committee chair, Mary Ann Larkin in hospitality, Ginger Herriker with partnerships and Lorna Corbetta, caddy master. Equally important were the players who pitched in. The holiday decorations, personal warmth of committee members and the orderly tournament management, all played a part.
