At most tables the bidding was:

W N E S 1D Dbl 3D 4S

All Pass

At two tables, West bid 5D over South's 4S bid and went down two tricks doubled for -300, for an average score.

Against 4S, every West led his two top diamonds. South trumped the second diamond and cashed two rounds of trumps. Some South's figured West must hold the Heart Ace for his opening bid, so a heart was led. They lost two heart tricks and the Club King as well as the first diamond, to go down. Some South's saw that West must have the Heart Ace or the Club King. They correctly played a small club toward dummy's Jack. They didn't care who won the trick. If west had the King and won, then South would be able to discard dummy's small hearts on the high clubs. If East won the club trick, then West must have the Heart Ace. So the contract was safe.

However, if West pays attention, the contract should fail. East's 3D bid must show at least five diamonds. So, West should not play another diamond. A shift to hearts sets the contract.
