Unit Holds NAOP Final Sunday, October 12

The Palo Alto Unit has scheduled a NAOP Unit final on Sunday, October 12 at the Bridge Center. This is a two-session stratified flight A, B, C event for players who qualified in club NAOP games. Game times for the sessions are 1 p.m. and 7 p.m., The first session will play side by side with the regular Sunday Afternoon BC game.

The qualifiers, posted on the bulletin board at the Bridge Center, scored average or better or finished in the upper half of the their respective flights. The players who achieve the same success in this event will qualify for the District 21 finals set for the weekend of January 3, 2004. Overall winners in all flights will receive a mixture of red-gold points.

The October 12 date is a reschedule from the October 5 game listed in the April *Kibitzer*. There will be no game on October 5. The game regularly held on Sunday at 1:00 p.m. will also be held.
