A Bridge Blast!

The Firecracker Sectional July 1-5 at Rickey's

Bridge is always a blast! But, things really boom in Palo Alto at our Unit's celebrated Firecracker Sectional! The tournament gets underway at Rickey's Hyatt on Thursday evening, July 1, and continues through Monday, July 5. Invite all your friends to join in the Firecracker fun. Rickey's has a special room rate for players.

There's a game for everyone: knockout teams; Swiss teams; stratified open pairs; stratified intermediate/novice pairs; and game times, morning afternoon and night, to please all. Intermediate/novice pair games are part of every session every day. An early finish on the July 4 holiday guarantees players time for bridge, barbecues and Technicolor fireworks. The Firecracker Sectional flyer, reprinted on page 4, lists the tournament schedule in detail.

Get started for a weekend of fun on Thursday evening with stratified open pairs and intermediate/novice pairs for players with under 200 points. There will be a separate area for the players in the intermediate/novice division with stratification for players with 0-5, 0-20, 0-50, 0-100 and 0-200 points. Friday marks the first two rounds of the popular bracketed knockout teams plus more pair contests. A special innovative feature this year is 3 pair sessions with morning, afternoon and evening start times. Knockout team rounds continue on Saturday afternoon and conclude that same evening. Again, stratified open pairs and intermediate/novice pairs will be on the program both Saturday and Sunday. Note the start times for both sessions on these two days.

All's well that ends well with both the popular Swiss teams in a strati-flighted format plus stratified open pairs, intermediate, and novice pairs on tap for the final Monday.

Chairmen Gloria Leitstein and Bernadine Donoghue have chosen some top aces as committee chairs. Mary Ann Larkin, with the help of Barbara Sonsini, will chair the hospitality committee, Ginger Herrick will be at the partnership desk and Lorna Corbetta will direct the caddies.

NAP Games to Start in June

Several clubs will hold NAP (North American Pairs) games in June. This will give players a chance to qualify for the next level and to earn extra masterpoints. Take a look at the back page calendar for a list of scheduled games.

To increase participation in the NAP, the ACBL has reduced sanction fees and allows clubs to schedule two qualifying events. During the coming summer months other clubs will schedule NAP games. Watch the *Kibitzer* for these opportunities to pile up the points.

Players who place in the overalls earn sectionally-rated half red and half black masterpoints. Any player who scores average or in the upper half will be eligible to play in a twosession Unit final scheduled in the fall.

It Seems to Me By Gersh Wheeler

Here is another recent hand (I sat South):

NORTH ▲ AQ42 ♡ K2 ◇ 32 ▲ A9842

The bidding:

South (Dealer)	West	North	East
1 ≜	Pass	2NT (alert)	Pass
4 ≜ (alert)	Pass	Pass	Pass

When East asked what the alert of 2NT was, I said that partner had four spades and enough to force to game. East said, "Oh, Jacoby." When North alerted my 4 bid and was asked to explain, he said. "Minimum opener, no singleton or void."

West led the \clubsuit J. I took the A in dummy, and then took two rounds of spades ending in dummy. Then I led the \clubsuit 2. East assumed his partner had the ten since he had led the jack. So East played the six, and my ten won the trick. I made six for a top.

My partner had alerted that I had no singleton, so East should have known that the missing ten was in my hand.

These are very common errors. Before playing to the first trick, try to imagine your opponents' distribution from the bidding. It's easy to forget the bidding during the play of the hand, but if you do, it will cost you.
