### **Bridge Bash—December 5**

To show the Unit's appreciation to all the players for support throughout the year and especially at the Firecracker Sectional, the Unit will host free dinner and free bridge to all comers on Sunday, December 5 at the Bridge Center. Game time is 2 p.m. and the dinner will be after the game.

The Unit has contracted with Chef Chu for a catered dinner. In addition, there will be wine and a dessert table, organized by Hansa Narasimhan. However, to ensure that the Unit has an accurate count on the number of participants, sign up on the Bridge Center list, when posted - about November 14. Make a firm commitment. The Unit will assess no-shows who signup and do not cancel a fee of \$10 to cover the cost of food ordered.

### **Money Bridge with Hansa**

I have to tell my story of a team game I played in for big money. It was the 30th Cavendish Invitational. The Cavendish was originally held in New York but is now in Las Vegas. For me it was the first time and I was so excited. There, as usual, were all the big stars of the bridge world (the bridge royalty). (In fact, when I was told that one of them had gone to get his crown fixed, silly old me thought a gem had fallen out of his crown; didn't imagine it was merely a visit to his dentist). First, there was the team event - entry fee \$10,000. (Yes. You counted the zeros right!) This year the World Bridge Productions, which conducts this event, is holding a second team event for which the entry fee will be only \$1,000. So gather up your favorite teammates and hope to see you there.

The most fun part of this event (after playing) is the Cavendish auction, where the top players are auctioned off like horses. You can buy a pair for a minimum price of \$12,500 but you can bid up the price. Last year the top pair went for around \$56,000. That was the debonair Norberto Bocchi & his partner Duboin. Norberto, who is very popular with the ladies and they really jacked up their price. There is a second pairs event for second rate players like me where the entry fee is \$750. These pairs are also bid on. After deducting the expenses, all the money is plowed back as winnings. Last year \$1.4 million was paid out as prize money.

### **Abridgements**

Local experts will post mortem hands with players after club morning games on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Ed Barlow will review hands on Monday and Wednesday and Will Watson on Friday. These sessions start on October 25 with no post mortem on Friday, October 29. The cost is \$2 per player.
