The Unit has done it again! Special thanks to John Hornback, the Tournament Chair and his innumerable staff, the Unit had another smashing Sectional success! John has been a member of the ACBL for 10 years and, fortunately for us, transferred to our unit 4 years ago. This is his second year on the Board, first running our Unit games then the Firecracker. We had 10 sessions of 767 tables, beating all attendance since the 780.5 in 1997. The totals for all the sessions were: Fri. eve 62, Sat 22, 109, 72, Sun 81, 82, Mon. 97, 92, Tues. 81, 69. The open pairs table count was 281, the I/N pairs 113, the KO 75, the Compact KO 124 and Swiss 174.

The player participation was greater than the Unit had hoped for in spite of unforeseen problems with access to the parking garage. The Hyatt Regency and Convention Center served us well.
