
# UNIT AFFAIRS

# Frances Miller

She doesn't own the Miller Brewing Company, as her frequent partner claims. She isn't Greta Garbo, as she has claimed. Nor can she speak fluent Japanese. All of those claims are manifestations of her sense of humor, her de-

sire "to make people laugh." Frances Miller, our most recent nonagenarian, spoke the other day about "how great my life is."

It might be bridge or it might be the good fortune to have had an ideal job that produces the happy outlook she has. Frances is eager to credit the two big influences in her life - music and bridge.

Her love of music began as she listened to the Texaco production of the Metropolitan Opera over the radio as a child, hearing Jan Pierce sing from *La Boheme*, and being profoundly moved. Much later, after waiting in line for a ticket to the Royal Ballet for her daughter who was studying ballet, she told the ticket agent, "I'd like a job here." He hired her, and soon she became the manager of the subscription service—according to her, the best job in the world. She got to see all the operas and concerts and visiting musicians that came to New York, and at the same time used her people skills, working out specific problems people had with their tickets or transportation or exchanges.

At the same time, she managed to fit in bridge games every evening. She had learned the game at the age of 12, loved it, found duplicate bridge after a shaky beginning, a real challenge. She never joined ACBL; she claims that the challenge itself is better than the accumulation of points.

When she resigned her job at the age of 71—computers had taken over and removed the joy of dealing directly with people—she then was able to play bridge every day *and* every night, and loved it more than ever.

Frances was born in Philadelphia, attended Temple University and studied business, but didn't like it. "All I can do is talk," she says. She lived with her husband in Silver Springs, Maryland, near Washington, where a friend invited her to all the embassy parties—contributing to her "great life." When her husband died six years ago, she moved to California to be near one of her two daughters. She has six granddaughters and eight great grandchildren, scattered from the east coast to Vietnam. Everyone came to celebrate her 90<sup>th</sup> birthday in April—more joy for her "great life."
