The opponents love to intrude after we open the bidding. This course discusses ways to overcome hurdles the opponents put in our way, and to penalize them when they bid too much. The auction often suggests which points will be working fully and which will be of little value. See how partner's and the opponents' bids identify the fine points and the shabby points. Explore when to upgrade the right points to bid aggressive games and slams - and when to settle for a partscore. When we play the hand, we will plan at trick one to succeed in the end position. Learn special matchpoint play techniques.
